- With Special OPD for Senior Citizens and differently-abled people, ESIC Hospitals become more accessible to all. They will not have to stand in queues anymore and can consult a doctor at their convenience.
- Construction Workers are now included in ESI Scheme with its all benefits: Employer may avail the opportunity of registering their construction workers by logging in www.esic.nic.in. This initiative will provide social security to construction workers and equip them will all the benefits under ESI Scheme.
- Extending the coverage of ESI Scheme in North-East States: The ESI Scheme is being implemented in Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Andaman & Nicobar Island.
